FAQs

Does Young Life Insurance cover Non-Young Life groups/individuals while at camp (ex. slip and break arm) or on the way to camp?	➡	No, their own insurance is in effect.
Does Young Life Insurance cover drop-in guests while at camp (ex. slip and break arm)?	➡	Covered under each property’s general liability insurance unless not Young Life’s fault (ex. trip on broken sidewalk, Young Life covers; trip from clumsiness, their insurance covers).
Does Young Life Insurance cover adult guests while at camp?	➡	Each adult guest should fill out a Health, Consent & Release Form (YL-6007).
